DEADLINE: MAY 13, 2011**

What is the New Jersey Young Film & Videomakers Festival?

The New Jersey Young Film & Videomakers Festival provides young video and filmmakers the opportunity to exhibit their works and have them evaluated by prominent representatives in the field of media arts. Since its inception, the purpose of the Festival has been to recognize, celebrate, and encourage emerging student talent in New Jersey, the state in which Thomas Edison first developed the motion picture.

Entry Eligibility

Individuals between 6 and 26 years of age who reside in New Jersey are eligible. Students from New Jersey who are enrolled in schools or colleges out of the state are also eligible. Enter in one of the following categories:

Category A – Elementary School, Middle School, or Junior High School

Category B – High School

Category C – Undergraduate College, Graduate School, or Independent

***(To be eligible in this category, you must have produced work in a non-commercial setting, and be between the ages of 18 – 26 years of age.)**

Entry Formats

Initially, entries are accepted on DVD or mini-DV, regardless of their original production format. Later, for exhibition, works should be readily available in their intended release format: 35mm, 16mm, Super 8mm film, DVD or mini-DV. For example, if a 16mm film is submitted on DVD, a 16mm print should be available for the Festival Tour. If you choose to send a film print, it must be mounted on a normal reel. Do not send film prints on cores!

Entry Procedure

Each Entry must be accompanied by:

- One Entry Form (photocopies are fine)
- \$15 Entry Fee (Checks are payable to Edison Media Arts)
- There is no minimum length, but the maximum length is 45 minutes
- Title of work, name, phone number, and e-mail of entrant must be on all materials and containers
- A synopsis describing the work with main credits
- Entries should be received no later than May 13, 2011

NOTE: The festival reserves the right to impose a \$15 surcharge for missing fees, bounced checks, or work received after the deadline of May 13, 2011.

- Due to the volume of entries we cannot return tapes and DVDs. Non-winning works submitted on film will be returned during June, provided that return mail packaging with address label and postage is affixed.

Exhibition of Award Winners

The Premiere Event and the Award Reception will take place at New Jersey City University (date TBA) with several follow up programs at participating organizations. Last year's host organizations included the AMC Cinema at Essex Green and The South Orange Public Library.

Awards

- \$1,000 or more in Main Category Prizes – divided among the prize winners as the jury directs.

Agreements

- Films and videos should be available for the Festival's extended tour through June '09. Any exhibition format is appropriate, but for preview purposes please send only DVD or VHS (NTSC). Submission of work indicates that the festival may curate and assemble selected and award-winning works into temporary traveling programs to be exhibited in the annual tour (occasionally compiled in DVD format groupings) serving host venues of the film festival. Submission of work also indicates that the festival may employ moving images and stills from selected works for promotion via print and broadcast outlets, the internet and other usual means.

Disclaimer

- Every precaution will be exercised in handling entries, but neither the festival organizers, employees, sponsors, nor participating organizations can assume responsibility for damage to or loss of materials submitted, including film prints, DVDs, videos etc. The festival reserves the right to alter the benefits, awards or timetable stated in this prospectus, should conditions dictate.

Jurying

- Qualified officials initially review all entries. Following the jurors' decision in May, the Festival Director and Program Associate consider additional work for inclusion in the tour. Decisions will be announced at the end of May just prior to the Festival Premiere.

- Every filmmaker and videomaker sets out to accomplish different goals: the jurors evaluate a work on the basis of the apparent intent of the entrant and the degree to which he or she was succeeded in reaching individual goals. All styles and forms of film and video are of interest to the jurors, and no one style or type of work is considered inherently more important than another. Jurors look for originality of concept and treatment, and each entry is also judged against others within a given age category and in the context of the overall creative and technical accomplishments. Judges' commentary and scores will be included with the award announcement.
